

W2 Tremblant-Dec 2023, Self-Drive Option (5 nights)

Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

Refer to the description for W1 Tremblant-Dec 2023 for an outline of the resort.

This trip is a self-drive option primarily for HPSC instructors who want 4 days of skiing (T,F,S,S) overlapped with the 2-day (S,S) bus trip. Note that the lift ticket dates are in sequence and can't be random.

For non-instructors, the resort offers free mountain tours for all levels at 9:30 am and 1:30 pm every day.

For double, triple or quad occupancy, you MUST pre-arrange your roommate(s) before registering. You cannot register as a single unless you agree to pay the full cost of the suite.

Dates

Wednesday December 13, 2023 – Monday December 18, 2023

What does it cost (per person)

A. Hotel suite: 1 bedroom 2D + full kitchen

\$825.00 – double occupancy, includes 4-day lift ticket.

\$585.00 – double occupancy, without lift tickets (includes IKON pass holders).

B. Hotel suite: 2 bedroom 3D + full kitchen

\$745.00 – triple occupancy, includes 4-day lift ticket.

\$505.00 – triple occupancy, without lift tickets (includes IKON pass holders).

C. Hotel suite: 2 bedroom 3D + full kitchen

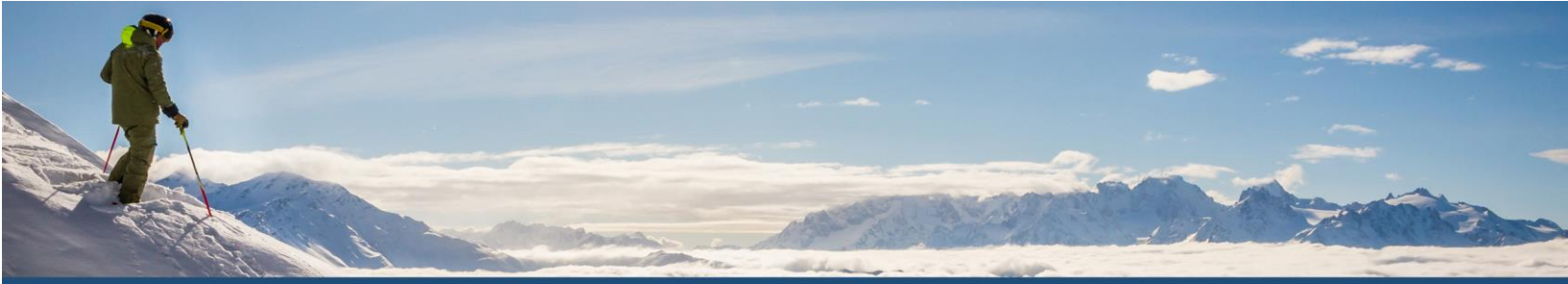
\$645.00 – quad occupancy, includes 4-day lift ticket.

\$405.00 – quad occupancy, without lift tickets (includes IKON pass holders).

What's included

Accommodation

Hotel Plaza St-Bernard in the Tremblant village. You will be assigned a suite in either Deslauriers building or Johannsen building at the discretion of Tremblant management. These are condo units with a full kitchen. No food is included. You may check in any time after 4:00 PM on December 13. Check out time is 11:00 AM on December 18.

Lift Tickets

4-day lift tickets are included. Lift ticket dates are in sequence and can't be random.

IKON pass holders may use their IKON pass instead of 4-day lift ticket for a reduction of \$240

Meals

No meals are included. There is a small grocery store in the Village with food to purchase. Or you may bring food and kitchen supplies (ie, paper towels, foil wrap, etc) with you.

Departure

Departure time is on your own schedule. Check in at the resort office is any time after 4:00 pm

Parking

There are two options for parking at the resort. Outdoor parking is free and is located beyond P1 which is below the cabriolet lift. Indoor parking can be purchased at the resort for \$20 per night. Payment would be made at the check in desk.

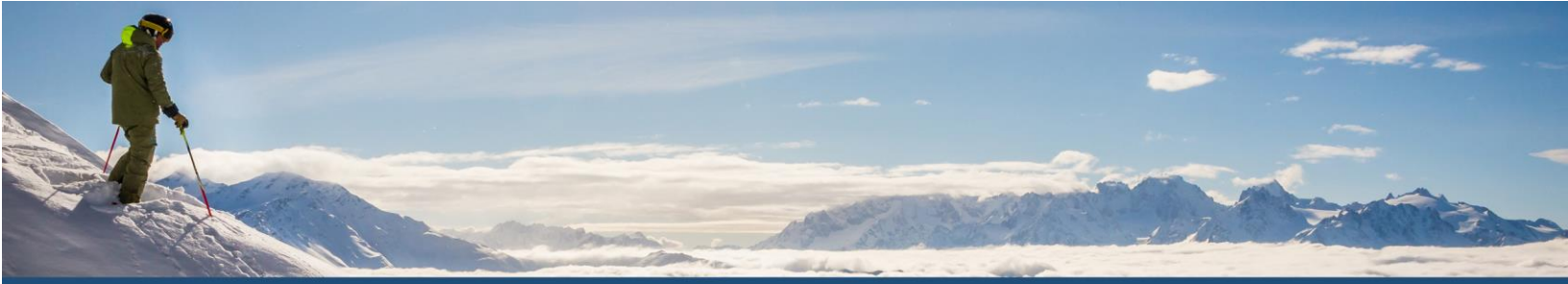
Travel Insurance
