What you should know and fine print

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Policy for this trip is set by the Tour Operator, not HPSC. Please consider your commitment carefully before booking your trip.

- All deposits (\$100 + \$155 + \$850) and Insurance Premium are non-refundable.
- Single room option cost must be covered. This means that if you cancel from the single room option, another single must be found to replace your room otherwise the single supplement is also not refundable.
- From January 10, 2024 to February 15, 2024, 70% non-refundable.
- From February 16, 2024 to departure, total holiday cost and Insurance Premium are non-refundable.
- Please note that any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded as per conditions above.
- Participants must submit a claim to their insurance company if they cancel after the above date.

Optional Travel Insurance

Comprehensive Travel Insurance is available to protect non-refundable payments in the event that participants are forced to cancel their vacation prior to departure or interrupt vacation due to medical reasons. "Cancel for Any Reason" coverage can be added to a newly purchased policy. The premium is due with the deposit to the tour operator. Insurance payments must accompany the deposit in order to be valid. Cost of insurance varies per person. To get the proper quote you must specify your full name, age, DOB, mailing address, phone number, email address, the options chosen and total trip cost. After you have registered, paid the \$100 non-refundable deposit and completed Stage-2 of the registration procedure including a further \$155 deposit, you will contact the Tour Operator for a quote.

Merit Travel offers trip cancellation insurance with Allianz Global Assist and a "Cancel For Any Reason" rider can be added for an additional 25% supplement. This allows cancellation for any reason up to 7 days prior to receive a refund of 75% of the prepaid travel arrangements, and from 6 days to 48 hours for a refund of 75% up to a maximum of \$1,500.00, and within 48 hours the cancellation must be for medical reasons only for any refund. "Cancel for any reason" rider must be purchased at the time of deposit.

Insurance is non-refundable from date of issuance. Please note that any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded as per conditions above. Passengers must submit a claim to their insurance company if they cancel after the above dates.

Club Med In-Resort Emergency Assistance

Club Med covers all participants with a limited insurance plan for medical reasons while at the resort, which is included in the cost of the vacation. Club Med offers In-Resort Emergency Assistance free of charge to guests traveling through December 31, 2024, which covers emergency medical expenses. It does not cover any cancellation prior to arrival, or return transportation cost if you cannot travel with the group.

The Fine Print

Trip participants must communicate directly with their group leader for questions or concerns about the trip and are not to contact the tour operator directly, except for insurance quotes (see above).





All applicable fuel surcharges and taxes in effect as of August have been included in the package price. However in these volatile times the tour operator reserves the right to charge for unanticipated increases in the cost of fuel and taxes imposed by the resort or airline.
